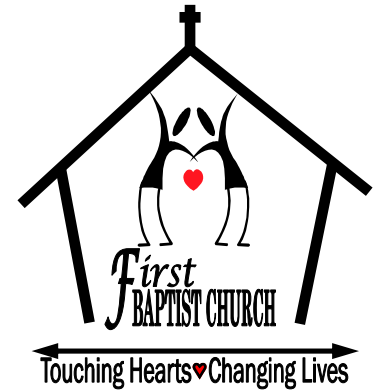

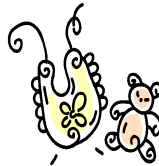
An Encouraging Word Bro. Greg
